It is a privately-owned company with the Wegmann Holding Company subsidiary Wegmann & Co GmbH having a 51 per cent stake and Siemens 49 per cent. (KMW employees 3,200 people). KMW has formed a number of subsidiaries, including ATM Computer Systems (military communications and IT), GLS (Gesellschaft für Logistischen Service) (armoured vehicle parts distributor, modernisation programmes), KMW Welding Technology (armoured vehicle welding)

Following the 2004 bankruptcy of its Dutch partner in the Fennek 4x4 ARV project for the German and Dutch armies, SP Aerospace and Vehicle Systems BV, KMW established a new firm to undertake production in the Netherlands, Dutch Defence Vehicle Systems (DDVS) BV. KMW has a 36 per cent stake in the Artec (ARmoured Vehicle TEChnology) consortium building the Boxer armoured vehicle for the German and Dutch armies. KMW and Rheimentall Landsysteme formed the joint venture PSM (Projekt System und Management) in 2002 to develop the modular Puma Infantry Fighting Vehicle (IFV) to replace the Marder in German Army service in 2010–2020.
